FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

Today we celebrate the baptism of Jesus Christ in the Jordan River. The Son of God freely sought ought and received the baptism of John the Baptist, which foreshadowed the sacrament of baptism. By receiving John's baptism of repentance even though, being sinless, He had no need to repent, Christ humbly signaled His union with us, the sinful humans He had come to save. Right after Christ's baptism, the visible descent of the Holy Spirit on Him in the form of a dove and the Father's public declaration, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased." also signal Christ's union with the other two Persons of the Holy Trinity. The events of that day were meant to show that Jesus Christ is both fully human and fully divine.
