

TRAVELING CHALICE

During Advent, we invite families to participate in a special prayerful initiative by bringing the "Traveling Chalice" home for a week to pray for vocations.

How it works:

- 1.) A family signs up for one of the Sunday Masses during the 4 Sundays of Advent.
- 2.) The family which has the chalice prays a short prayer for vocations included with the Chalice every day for the whole week.
- 3.) The family brings the chalice back on the weekend and it in turn is presented to the next family at Mass.
