BLESSING OF CHALK ON EPIPHANY

The blessing of chalk on Epiphany is a tradition in which priests bless chalk for each family so that they may bless their homes as a witness of their faith and protection against evil. The formula is simple: take blessed chalk and write the following above the entrance of your home:

C+M+B+2025

The inscription "C+M+B" is an abbreviation of the Latin phrase "Christus Mansionem Benedicat." which means "May Christ bless this house." St. Augustine offered a different interpretation of this abbreviation, expanding it as "Christus Multorum Benefactor," meaning "Christ, benefactor of many." However, this interpretation did not gain widespread popularity among Christians. From A pastoral perspective, it is important to emphasize that the inscription on the door during the Feast of the Epiphany is primarily a reminder of Christ's presence in the life of the family and an invitation to open oneself to His blessing every time one passes through the door.
