# SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD:

"I HOPE IN YOUR WORD" (PSALM 119:74) The Third Sunday of Ordinary Time marks the celebration of Bible Sunday in the Diocese of Hamilton. 
#### PASTORAL VISITS
